Collectively, we employ over 7,000 staff and are in the top three employers of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the country.

Despite the outcome of the referendum on the Voice in 2023, our sector remains strong, collectively building on our successes to improve Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health and well-being. NACCHO's National Member's Conference is an important space for our organisations to come together and celebrate these successes and lessons learnt.

This event will be widely promoted throughout Australia through our social media platforms, which have a collective following of over 70,000 people, by email and via the dedicated NACCHO Conference website. In 2023, NACCHO promoted over 100 conference posts on our social media channels which received 319,000 impressions and 17,000 engagements.

NACCHO'S Vision

Aboriginal people enjoy quality of life through whole-of-community self-determination and individual spiritual, cultural, physical, social and emotional wellbeing. Aboriginal health in Aboriginal hands.

NACCHO is the national leadership body for Aboriginal health in Australia. It provides informed advice and guidance to the Australian Government on policy and budget matters that will contribute to the quality of life for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

NACCHO represents 145 Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations (ACCHOs) that manage and operate over 300 clinics providing primary health care to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people across Australia. ACCHOs provide over 3.1 million episodes of care each year for over 410,000 people. The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander population has a growth rate of 3.4 per cent per year (over twice as high as the non-Indigenous population, which was 1.4 per cent).



National Conference 2024


2 December 2024 National Convention Centre, Canberra Ngunnawal & Ngambri Country

- 3 All monies are payable in Australian dollars. EFT transfers can be arranged and are preferred.

- **5** In the event of the withdrawal of a Sponsorship, NACCHO should be notified in writing as soon as possible. Please note the following cancellation fees:
